And bid me to come to Thee, That with Thy saints, I may praise Thee

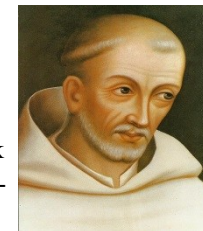
