Wis 9: 13-18 Ps 90 (89) Phm 9b-10, 12-17 Lk 14: 25-23

Still on the way to Jerusalem and his death, Jesus challenges the crowds on their commitment to him. Language about hating family etc, sounds strange to our ears, but in Jesus 'own language, there was no way of expressing preference. So instead of saying that a disciple must opt for him in preference to any other, he has to talk about loving him and hating others. Strange words, but they should help reflect on own priorities.


