

Is 6: 1-2a, 3-8 Ps 138 (137) 1 Cor 15: 1-11 Lk 5: 1-11

The Gospel of Luke shares some stories with John. This one is rather similar to a story found at the very end of John's Gospel. It is often described as the call of disciples, but clearly Jesus and the fishermen are already known to each other. The point of the story about Peter is that perfection is not a condition of discipleship: recognising personal sinfulness and desire to follow Jesus are what count.

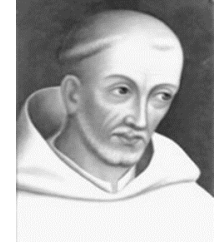
