From the malignant enemy, defend me. In the hour of my death, call me, and bid me to come to Thee, That with Thy saints, I may praise Thee

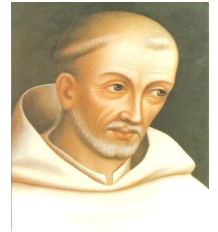
