We already heard this Gospel on Trinity Sunday. Jesus tells Nicodemus, the Pharisee who came to him by night, that the Son of Man must be lifted up so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life. This leads to the famous statement of God's purpose for humanity: God loved the world so much that he gave up his only Son so that the world might be saved. Thus, the Cross is exalted, the Feast is a Triumph.

Help us to be kind, loving, and forgiving, just as You are.




