

Acts 1:12-14 Psalm 27 (26); 1 Ptr 4:13-16; Jn 17: 1-11a

The prayer of Jesus focusses on the concept of Glory. In Hebrew "Glory" has the same root as the word for the liver, the heaviest organ of the body, and so can be thought of as meaning "giving weight" to something. Jesus glorifies the Father when he gives the most weight to the Father's will and fulfilling the mission her has been entrusted with. We in turn give glory to God, when we allow the things of God to tip the scales in our lives and become the most pressing focus, the most important voice.

From the malignant enemy, defend me. In the hour of my death, call me,

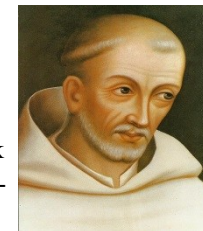
And bid me to come to Thee, That with Thy saints, I may praise Thee
