Prov 9: 1-16 Ps 33 Eph 5: 15-20 Jn 6: 51-58

This passage reminds us what will be the outcome of Jesus' journey to Jerusalem - his death. The thought of it prompts Jesus to describe what lies ahead as a baptism with which he has still to be baptised. Not another immersion in water, surely? We might note that baptism literally means immersion. Jesus is immersed in his mission - his death. No wonder he is preoccupied. "Distressed" does not express this well - he is obsessed, rather than distressed.
