

Is 55: 6-9 Ps 145 (144) Phil 1: 20c-24,27a Mt 20:1-16

This famous parable about the vineyard of the Lord, tells of people engaged to work in the vineyard at different times of the day. The agreed wage: one denarius—the minimum wage of the time. Those who worked longer expected more, but the denarius is a symbol of what sustains life: God's gift, not something earned. What kind of owner would, pay less than enough to live on? God gives life itself as gift, not as wage.

Within Thy Wounds hide me. Suffer me not to be separated from Thee.

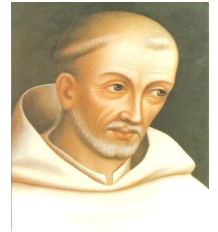
From the malignant enemy, defend me. In the hour of my death, call me, and bid me to come to Thee, That with Thy saints, I may praise Thee

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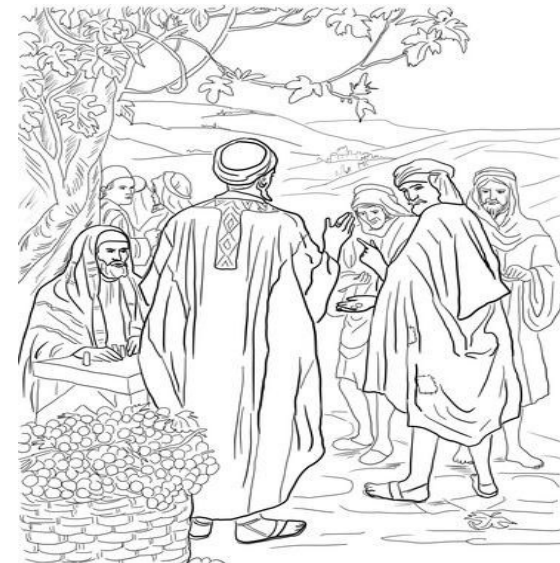
