Jesus frequently dines with the Pharisees in Luke's gospel and he seldom spares his hosts! On this occasion, Jesus notices the fight for the best places at table - a sign of social status. Jesus offers two comments. First, don't risk being moved to a lower place at table when someone more important arrives. Second, dinners etc, should be used as an opportunity to do good to the poor and others who cannot repay the favour.
